STAIN REMOVAL

Your carpet is a fabric product: in case of a stain, fast intervention will help you solve the problem. We recommend acting as soon as the stain appears. Any dirt mark is more difficult to remove the older it is.

The choice of cleaning products to be used for stain removal on carpets requires great vigilance. The use of an unsuitable product may lead to irreversible discoloration. Fabric floor coverings are sensitive to chemical agents: the fibers and the backing can be damaged by aggressive chemical agents such as alkaline products and bleaching agents (bleach, hydrogen peroxide, etc.) In general, only use cleaning products specifically recommended for use on carpet. To do this, carefully read the recommendations on the packaging and the technical sheet. In all cases, strictly follow the usage recommendations.

Before using a new product, we suggest checking that it does not affect the color of the carpet by carrying out a test on a scrap or a small area that is not visible. The pH of the products used must not exceed 8. Never spray a product not intended for cleaning directly or indirectly onto the carpet (perfume, deodorant, essential oils, etc.) Furthermore, regardless of the product used, systematically ensure that no residue is left on the carpet. The use of a cleaning product must usually be followed by rinsing with water.

TYPE OF STAIN	STAIN REMOVAL PRODUCT / METHOD
Greasy : Butter, oil, grease, tar, wax, mustard, ketchup, lipstick, sugary food, sugary drink.	DIVERSEY (Taski Tapi Spotex 1 and 2), ORAK (GS1) UNIPRO (Active bio and Solvastain)
Tanic : Wine, coffee, tea, blood, cola, wood stain, vomit.	UNIPRO KF100 and KF200, ORAK (CS1) baking soda, hydrogen peroxide for fabrics (10% vol.)
Candle wax	Remove as much wax as possible by gentle scraping. Then place blotting paper on the stain and apply a warm iron without pressing. Repeat, moving the blotting paper until the wax is completely absorbed. Finish by dabbing the stain with a cloth soaked in a detergent for greasy stains.
Mud	Leave to dry, then brush. Dab with a cloth soaked in carpet shampoo if required. (For example, DIVERSEY tapi Shampoo, ORAK Hydrox, UNIPRO natural). Rinse.
Chewing-gum	Harden the chewing gum with ice or DIVERSEY (Taski tapi gum), then remove using the back of a knife blade.
Milk, egg, yogurt, chocolate, grass	Spread over Terre de Sommières (fine clay) or plant sponge, brush, vacuum.
Glue, varnish	Dab with a cloth soaked in acetone. Rinse with clean water.
Paint	Dab with a cloth soaked in White Spirit. Rinse with clean water.
Ink, pen	Spray UNIPRO Solvastain or apply baking soda, leave to act, dab with a cloth, rinse with water.
Rust	Dab with a cloth soaked in the rust removal product (diluted oxalic acid or oxalic acid salt). Rinse with clean water.
Nail varnish	Dab with a cloth soaked in nail varnish remover.
